**Delray Beach Art Trail – [www.delrayarttrail.com](http://www.delrayarttrail.com) - \$5,000 (plus extended research labor required – ongoing)**

The Downtown Development Authority (DDA) created a thoughtfully curated Delray Beach Art Trail website showcasing the DDA District's vast collection of artistic offerings from 195 to the beach. The purpose of the Art Trail is to showcase the Downtown Delray Beach's wealth of arts culture and vast inventory of art works in a central location inviting the community and visitors from around the world to come discover hidden gems that secure the city's place as a dynamic arts destination in Southeast Florida.

**"2021 Observations" - Mural Restoration in Progress - \$10,000 DDA funding**

Final location: Delray Camera Shop & Studios (217 NE 4th Avenue)

Artist Dana Donaty

- Nine (9) metal mural panels currently in restoration at Arts Warehouse
- Restoration funded by the DDA and CRA; administration: Pineapple Grove Art Board.
- Panels to be reinstalled November, 2021 at 217 NE 4th Avenue
- Metal panels to be augmented by additional painting on exterior wall of new location
- "2021 Observations" mural to be completed in December 2021/January 2022

**Update:**

- Mural repainting is 50% complete and installation on new site to take place end of November/early December. (All new sky – more depth of color)
- Additional painting to take approximately 2 months before reveal.
- DDA Creating short social media interview videos to inform public
