- **WHEREAS**, the City of Delray Beach, Florida is committed to ensuring the safety and security of all those living in and visiting Delray Beach; and
- **WHEREAS**, U.S. fire departments responded to 1,291,500 home fires in 2019, according to the U.S. Fire Association (USFA); and
- **WHEREAS**, U.S. home fires resulted in 3,704 civilian deaths in 2019, representing the majority (72 percent) of all U.S. fire deaths; and
- WHEREAS, newer homes are built with lightweight materials that burn faster than older home constructions; and
- **WHEREAS**, these conditions contribute to a much smaller window of time for people to escape a home fire safely, with people having as little as one to two minutes to escape from the time the smoke alarm sounds; and
- **WHEREAS**, a home fire escape plan includes two exits from every room in the home; a path to the outside from each exit; smoke alarms in all required locations; and a meeting place outside where everyone in the home will meet upon exiting; and
- **WHEREAS**, practicing a home fire escape plan twice a year ensures that everyone in the household knows what to do in a real fire situation; and
- **WHEREAS**, Delray Beach's first responders are dedicated to reducing the occurrence of home fires and home fire injuries through prevention and protection education; and
- **WHEREAS**, Delray Beach's residents are responsive to public education measures and are able to take personal steps to increase their safety from fire, especially in their homes; and
- **WHEREAS**, the 2021 Fire Prevention Month theme is, "Learn the Sounds of Fire Safety". From beeps to chirps, this year's campaign works to better educate the public about the sounds smoke alarms make, what those sounds mean, and how to respond to them.

NOW THEREFORE, I Shelly Petrolia, Mayor of the City of Delray Beach do hereby proclaim October 2021 as:

Fire Prevention Month

throughout this community and urge all of Delray Beach to participate in the many public safety activities and efforts of Delray Beach's Fire Rescue Department during Fire Prevention Month 2021.
