APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO THE EXISTING INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF GULF STREAM AND THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH TO PROVIDE FIRE RESCUE SERVICES.

### **Recommended Action:**

Staff recommends the approval of Amendment No. 3 to the existing Interlocal Agreement with the Town of Gulf Stream, for the purpose of receiving financial compensation for Fire Rescue services.

### **Background:**

On July 14, 2009, the Town of Gulf Stream entered into an interlocal agreement with the City of Delray Beach for Fire Rescue services. These services are provided from existing Delray Beach Fire Stations. Amendment No. 3 extends the agreement by renewal for an additional five (5) year period beginning October 1, 2024, and expiring at midnight on September 30, 2029.
