ORDINANCE NO. 44-17 OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING ARTICLE III, "LEGISLATIVE," SECTION 3.03, "QUALIFICATIONS OF CANDIDATES; ELECTION", OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH CHARTER, TO AMEND THE QUALIFYING DATES FOR THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH'S GENERAL ELECTION AT THE REQUEST OF THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS. (SECOND READING)

Background:

This proposed ordinance seeks to amend the section 3.03 of the City of Delray Beach Charter as it relates to the qualifying period for candidates in municipal elections. This Ordinance simply mirrors Ordinance 41-17 which amended section 34 of the Code of Ordinances and is necessary to ensure consistency between the City Charter and Ordinances.
