PRIOR APPROVAL OF FISCAL YEAR 2017 SPENDING LIMIT GREATER THAN \$25,000 WITH A ONE FIRE EQUIPMENT, INC.

Recommended Action:

Motion to approve multiple acquisitions of less than \$25,000 each to A One Fire Equipment, Inc. for Fire Trucks, Ambulances and Heavy Equipment parts in a total not-to-exceed amount of \$35,000 for Fiscal Year 2017.

Background:

Fleet Division in the Environmental Services Department has an on-going requirement for parts in order to properly maintain the fleet of Fire trucks, ambulances and other equipment such as multifunction switches, battery chargers, electrical components, lights, brakes, intercom systems. A One Fire Equipment, Inc. frequently provides the lowest quotes for parts and the Fleet Division is requesting approval to use A One Fire Equipment, Inc. for multiple purchases during Fiscal Year 2017 in a not-to-exceed amount of \$35,000. To date in Fiscal Year 2017, A One Fire Equipment, Inc. has been awarded orders totaling \$2,864.

Spending amount over the past three years

2016- \$25,051

2015- \$11,911

2014- \$8,630

By approving the recommended motion, the Commission is recognizing that multiple small and

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unpredictable purchase decisions that are likely to occur over the course of the year will total over \$25,000. This amount of spending requires prior Commission approval under the City Code of Ordinances, Chapter 36, Section 36.03(B), "Multiple Acquisitions From Vendor Exceeding Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) in Any Fiscal Year".
