APPROVING AMENDMENT #2 TO THE VALET PARKING LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE AVENUE BAR & GRILL, INC, D/B/A 32 EAST PROVIDING VALET PARKING SERVICES TO EXTEND FOR ONE YEAR THE LICENSE TO PROVIDE VALET PARKING SERVICES IN THE CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH (CITY)

Recommended Action:

Motion to retroactively approve Amendment #2 to the Valet Parking License Agreements with The Avenue Bar & Grill, Inc, D/B/A 32 East providing valet parking services to extend the license from October 1, 2017 until September 30, 2018.

Background:

In 2014, the City of Delray Beach entered into Valet Parking License Agreements with The Avenue Bar & Grill, Inc, D/B/A 32 East in the Central Business District. Each of these license agreements was for a period of three years, including a 3 percent escalation clause annually. This agreement expires on September 30, 2017 and there is no month-to-month renewal clause. The new agreement will replace the existing agreement, extending the time. Should the Commission choose to raise the Valet Parking License Fee, this contract can be cancelled on 30-day notice and a new contract will be pursued including the new fee structure.
