### **Recommended Action:**

Motion to Approve application for the 2018 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$30,487.

### **Background:**

The Police Department is asking approval to apply for the 2018 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$30,487. If awarded, these funds will assist in funding police overtime for the annual Holiday Robbery Task Force.

### **City Attorney Review:**

### **Funding Source/Financial Impact:**

The reimbursable overtime for FY 18/19 will be funded in 001-21-150-521.14-20 (Field Operations - Overtime) and 001-21-110-521.14-20 (Special Services - Overtime) accounts, pending FY 18/19 budget approval. Reimbursement is provided through the U.S. Department of Justice's Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program.
