### **Background:**

This Resolution invokes the pending ordinance doctrine commencing no later than January 15, 2019 with respect to the preparation and review of proposed amendments to the City's Code of Ordinances pertaining to dockless mobility devices.

This Resolution adopts the pending ordinance doctrine as applied to the City's review of its ordinances. The City will defer the acceptance processing of applications for operations related to dockless mobility devices for 180 days. Staff has been reviewing the subject matter and potential Code changes related to same.
