Background:

On February 5, 2019, the City Commission adopted Resolution 44-19, invoking the pending ordinance doctrine with respect to consideration of amendments to the Code of Ordinances relating to the regulation of dockless mobility devices. The period established by Resolution 44-19 is set to expire on July 14, 2019. Due to the passing of House Bill 453, staff is requesting additional time to

consider changes to the Code of Ordinances in light of the new law regarding micromobility devices scheduled to go into effect on July 1, 2019.
