GRANT APPLICATION/EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG)

Recommended Action:

Motion to approve application for the 2019 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$29,379.

Background:

The Police Department is asking approval to apply for the 2019 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$29,379. If awarded, these funds will assist in funding police overtime for the annual Holiday Robbery Task Force.

City Attorney Review:

Approved as to form and legal sufficiency.

Funding Source/Financial Impact:

The reimbursable overtime for FY 19/20 would be funded in 001-21-150-521.14-20 (Field Operations - Overtime) and 001-21-110-521.14-20 (Special Services - Overtime) accounts, pending approval of this application as well as actual award through a FY 19/20 mid-year adjustment of both the expense accounts and revenue account. Reimbursement is provided through the U.S. Department of Justice's Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program.
