#### **Recommended Action:**

Staff recommends the approval to submit for several different grants under the FY 2019 Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG).

#### Background:

The Fire-Rescue Department is seeking permission to submit for several different grants under the FY 2019 Assistance to Firefighters Grant. The FY 2019 AFG grant requires the City to contribute 10 percent of the grant award. The Fire Rescue Department is submitting for several different grants in the estimated amount of \$ 1,585,300. The City's responsibility if all grants were awarded will be \$167,890. Below are the different grants the Fire Rescue Department is seeking to submit along with the FY 2019 AFG Funding, the City's funding and the total cost of the purchase. Please note they are not in any priority order.
