Background:

On July 9, 2019, the City Commission adopted Ordinance 26-19, imposing a temporary moratorium on the operation of retail businesses engaged in the sale of retail products containing cannabidiol/CBD sold as a principal retail product within the City for a period of one (1) year. The period established by Ordinance 26-19 is set to expire on July 8, 2020. Staff is requesting an additional 180 days to consider changes to the Code of Ordinances.
