NOMINATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEMS BOARD.

### **Recommended Action:**

Motion to approve the nomination for an appointment for two (2) regular members to serve on the Board of Trustees for the Police Retirement Systems Board for a four (4) year term ending October 4, 2024.

### **Background:**

The terms for regular members, Mr. Scott Privitera and Mr. Henry Dickson, have expired on October 4, 2020. Mr. Scott Privitera has served one (1) unexpired term, is eligible and would like to be nominated for reappointment. Mr. Henry Dickson has severed one (1) unexpired term, is eligible and would like to be nominated for reappointment. Nominations for appointments are needed for two (2) regular members to serve a four (4) year term ending October 4, 2024.

In accordance with Ordinance 17-16 of the City Code, the City Commission appoints two (2) public members to the Board of Trustees. All members must be a resident of the City of Delray Beach. All appointees must take an oath of office.

The following individuals have submitted applications and would like to be nominated for an appointment:
