### Background:

LGBTQ people are our family, friends, neighbors and co-workers who contribute meaningfully to our community and continues to contribute to the widespread academic, economic, artistic and social spheres within and around our greater community. The month of June was designated Pride Month to commemorate the Stonewall Riots which occurred 50 years ago in June of 1969 and are recognized as the catalyst of the LGBTQ rights movement.
