Background:

This Resolution, if approved, would authorize the City Manager to execute settlement agreements in the matter of *In re: National Prescription Opiate Litigation*, MDL No. 2804 (N.D. Ohio). The Commission has been presented with settlement offers in this matter and, in order to promote efficiencies and avoid delays, staff recommends authorizing the City Manager to execute any future settlements.
