### **Background:**

### **City Attorney Review:**

The City Attorney has reviewed the documents for legal sufficiency.

### **Funding Source/Financial Impact:**

The Town of Gulfstream provides 3.6% to 5.8% of the Building Fund revenue and comprises 3% to 20% of the building permits processed.

### **Timing of Request:**

A decision to adjust or terminate the current ILA is needed in advance of the transition to e-permitting.
