### NOMINATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE POLICE ADVISORY BOARD

#### **Recommended Action:**

Motion to approve the nomination for an appointment for two (2) regular board members to serve on the Police Advisory Board to serve an unexpired term ending July 31, 2023.

#### **Background:**

Due to the removal of one (1) board member, a vacancy has been created. Due to Ms. Latoya Boone's resignation, a vacancy has been created. Nomination for two (2) regular board members is needed to serve an unexpired term ending July 31, 2023.

Per Ordinances, Chapter 32, Sections 32.10. Where a vacancy has been caused by the resignation or removal of a member prior to the expiration of his or her term, a member shall be appointed to complete the unexpired term only unless the unexpired term is for a period of time less than six months. In that event, the appointed member shall be allowed to serve the following full regular term without reappointment.

To qualify for an appointment, a person shall be either a resident of, own property, own a business, or be an officer, director, or manager of a business located within the City of Delray Beach. Membership shall include a diverse cross-section of the community; business owners, religious and faith-based organizations, youth, school officials, and local organizations, where feasible.

The following individuals have submitted applications and would like to be nominated for an appointment:
