Item A1 - <u>SUNDY VILLAGE</u> - Motion to approve and accept a Maintenance of Traffic/ Road closure Plan for S. Swinton Ave., SW 1st Avenue, SW 1st Street and West Atlantic Avenue during construction of Phase 1 of the Sundy Village Project.

**Item A2 - <u>325 East Atlantic Avenue</u> -** Receive information concerning the pedestrian routing on East Atlantic Avenue during planned construction at 325 East Atlantic Avenue.

#### Background:

#### MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC PLAN/ ROAD & LANE CLOSURES

#### Item A1

Consider acceptance of a Maintenance of Traffic Plan by the development contractor for Sundy Village. This item exceeds 14 days in length and will require Commission approval.

#### Item A2

Receive information concerning the pedestrian routing on East Atlantic Avenue during planned construction at 325 East Atlantic Avenue. Although this closure will exceed 14 days in length, sidewalk closures are approved administratively.

There is no City cost now or in the future for these items.
