INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT - 2017 PALM BEACH COUNTY/DROWNING PREVENTION COALITION LEARN TO SWIM REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM

Recommended Action:

This request is for approval to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Palm Beach County Drowning Prevention Coalition ("DPC") for payment of swimming classes to the City of Delray Beach, to provide swimming classes to individuals who present vouchers issued by the DPC Learn to Swim Program.

Staff recommends approval of the Interlocal Agreement with Drowning Prevention Coalition's Learn to Swim Program for payment of swimming lesson fees to the City of Delray Beach, not to exceed \$50.00 per voucher.

Background:

The County through its Drowning Prevention Coalition's Learn to Swim Program, distributes vouchers to the public which may be redeemed for swimming lessons at Pompey Park Pool and Delray Swim and Tennis. The County reimburses the City up to \$50.00 per voucher. This will be the ninth year the City of Delray Beach will enter into an agreement with Palm Beach County to provide swimming lessons. We are anticipating 250 - 300 summer camp children will attend this program. Based on the Agreement, the City of Delray Beach will be required to invoice Palm Beach County monthly based on the number of swimming classes provided to individuals who have presented the DPC Learn to Swim voucher.
