### NOMINATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

#### **Recommended Action:**

Motion to Approve nomination for appointment for one (1) alternate member to serve on the Board of Adjustment for an unexpired term ending August 31, 2019.

#### **Background:**

There is a vacancy on the Board of Adjustment. The term is unexpired ending August 31, 2017. Per the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 32, Section 32.09, the appointed member shall be allowed to serve the following full regular term without reappointment because the unexpired term is for a period of time less than six months. Nomination for appointment is needed for one (1) alternate member.

The Board of Adjustment shall consist of five (5) regular members and two (2) alternate members. To qualify for appointment, a person shall be either a resident of or own property in the City, and/or own a business within the City. In addition, the City Commission shall fill three seats on the Board with either an architect, landscape architect, realtor/real estate broker, engineer, general contractor or land planner. The remaining two seats shall be at large. The Commission shall endeavor to appoint as many disciplines as possible to the board.

The following individuals have submitted applications and would like to be nominated for appointment:

A check for code violations and/or municipal liens was conducted. None were found. Voter registration verification was completed and all are registered.

Based on the rotation system, the nominations for appointment will be made by Commissioner Katz (Seat #3) for one (1) alternate member to serve an unexpired term ending August 31, 2019.
