### **INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH AND THE DELRAY BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY FOR FUNDING CONSTRUCTION/PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021**

#### **Recommended Action:**

Approve the Interlocal Agreements (ILA) between the City of Delray Beach and the Delray Beach Community Redevelopment Agency for funding for Capital Improvement Projects within the CRA District for Fiscal Year 2020-2021.

#### **Background:**

The implementation of many of the projects contained in the Community Redevelopment Plan, particularly the public infrastructure projects resulting from the adopted Neighborhood and Redevelopment Plans, require a joint City/CRA effort. The typical arrangement involves the CRA funding all or a portion of the project, and the City's Engineering or other staff overseeing the bidding and construction processes.

Each year the City and CRA enter into an interlocal agreement to formalize the CRA's commitment to fund the specific projects. This year's projects include the following:
