NOMINATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE PUBLIC ART ADVISORY BOARD

Recommended Action:

Motion to approve the nomination for an appointment for one (1) regular member to serve on the Public Art Advisory Board for an unexpired term ending July 31, 2021.

Background:

Due to the resignation of Ms. Stella Jurkiewicz there is a vacancy on the Public Art Advisory Board. Nomination for an appointment is needed for one (1) regular member to serve an unexpired term ending July 31, 2021.

The Land Development Regulations Article 8.5 enacted the Public Art Advisory Board to advise and make recommendations to the City Commission with respect to public art policy and related issues including, but not limited to, the selection, construction, and placement of public art in/on City right-of-way and City-owned property.

The Public Art Advisory Board shall consist of seven (7) members. Three (3) seats on the Board must be filled with either an artist, architect, landscape architect, or engineer. Laypersons of knowledge, experience, and judgment who have an interest in public art shall make up the Board's balance.
